Welcome to the first issue of the Europe & Law Journal of the European Public Law Center Alumni Association.

Each year, the Academy of the European Public Law Center awards a Diploma to students who participate and complete successfully the regular September session for two consecutive years, and prepare a dissertation on a topic relating to public law. This Journal will consist mainly of these dissertations, which are supervised by the members of the European Group of Public Law during the research year and defended before a Jury of three professors.

This Journal pursues two objectives. Firstly, it aims at disseminating the results of the research undertaken by the students, by publishing the best works sustained in the Academy. Secondly, it intends to open a forum for critical discussion of current and developing ideas, policies and practice in the field of Public Law.

Each issue will be structured in two sections. The first one will contain an article or an opinion by a distinguished member of the European Group of Public Law, together with the dissertations mentioned above presented by the students of the Academy.

A second section of the Journal will be dedicated to comments on legislation or on case law of different national legal orders. We welcome contributions from academics, legal practitioners and others by that section.
